Our Mission

BELIEVE International is committed to helping impoverished Filipino youth become productive, successful adults and leaders who exhibit a positive influence in their communities. This is accomplished by providing the needed resources for the very poor to attend school, encouraging excellence in academic studies and creating opportunities for students and their families to internalize positive core values and leadership skills.

A New Name

This has been a very exciting year for the Live to Learn Foundation. Many things have changed – including our name.

Since our inception in 2001 we have provided educational support to impoverished children in the Philippines, hoping to create self-reliance and job opportunities among our sponsored students.

In five years, 62 students have graduated from high school and now many are working or pursuing further education. Numerous lives have been changed, but we know we can do more!

In December 2006 we changed our name to **BELIEVE International** to reflect a new focus on helping youth understand and internalize core values and develop leadership skills. In addition to providing educational assistance, our volunteer coordinators periodically meet with the students and their families and teach core values. Students are encouraged to seek to understand and live these and practice them in their home with their family.

The name “**BELIEVE**” stands for **B**uilding **E**ffective **L**eadership, **I**ntegrity, **E**xcellence and **V**alues through **E**ducation.

Expanding Throughout the Philippines

In April of this year, two of our volunteers from the United States (Carvel and Betty Whiting) visited the Philippines, retraining all of our local volunteer coordinators in the new, expanded approach (teaching **BELIEVE** core values) and opening eight new areas, which more than doubled the number of cities where we have students.

With this expansion, effective last June for the 2007-2008 school year, we are now sponsoring students in fifteen different cities across the country and include the following:
